## Luxe summer skincare

There are various opinions on the who, what and where of skincare but if you're a fan of **layering**, you may find that as the weather turns, one layer has to give, to stave off shine. If you are a BB Cream fan, or you wear a separate SPF (as opposed to a cream or foundation containing one) the solution may be to forgo moisturiser for a few months and use a hydrating, power-packed **serum** instead.

I've found that by using **Clarins HydraQuench Intensive Serum Bi-Phase** (right) I can pass on my usual cream. Consisting of two layers, which you shake together, this has a surprising liquid texture – quite unlike other serums – which your skin drinks in. I find this a really **refreshing** hit. It contains Inca peanut extract, rich in fatty acids and also alfalfa (interestingly, alfalfa was first consumed by the Arabs, who were wise to its high protein content).

If you're worried about the efficacy of using a serum alone, **La Prairie's** new Cellular Power Serum (left) 'acts as a battery supplying energy to your cells to repair existing damage'. What this means is that instead of just being a typical, topical **antioxidant treatment**, it also taps into the skin's natural antioxidant 'self defence' network, which becomes tired over time; so it helps the skin help itself.

If you really can't step away from your moisturiser, switch to a more lightweight (in texture, not effect) serum, such as **Guerlain Super Aqua Serum Light** (right), a new version of their cult serum created for fans of the 'less is more' approach. This boasts a fresher 'feather-light' feel and matte finish.

### AT HOME

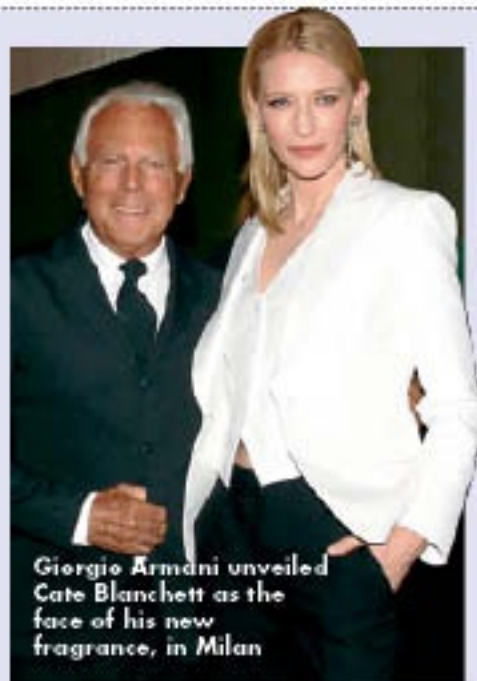
